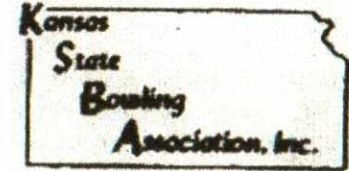

## KANSAS STATE SENIOR OPEN BOWLING TOURNAMENT

1. All participants in the Kansas State Senior Open Bowling Tournament, shall be USBC bowlers who have reached their 50th birthday on or before October 22, 2016 and who are members of a local association in the State of Kansas certified by the United States Bowling Congress. In the absence of a current membership card or proof of USBC affiliation, a participant must procure an affiliate membership card upon payment of \$20.00 dues.

2. This tournament will include competition in six classes and each class shall include competition in doubles, singles and all-events. The team event will be in a single class (all ages). The team and all events are optional events. Champions in each class of doubles, singles & all events will receive symbolic awards.

3. All entrants shall enter at their highest average based on a minimum of 21 games in a certified league, using their 2015 - 2016 book average. If no average for 2015 - 2016 season, use a 2016 summer league average of at least 21 games. If no summer league average, use a current average, of at least 21 games as of the time they bowl in the tournament. If bowler does not have any of the above averages, they may enter at 220.

4. Handicap to be based on 90% of the difference of the individuals entering average and 220.

5. Class will be determined by age on October 22, 2016. Team members and doubles partners do not have to be in the same age bracket.

### 6. TEAM EVENT - ALL ONE CLASS

7. Bowlers who enter doubles must also enter singles and vice versa. Bowlers may enter each event only once.

8. All Events scores will be determined by the addition of **The Doubles and Singles scores only. Team scores will not count towards All Events.**

9. The All Events winner in each class will have their entry paid into the National Senior Tournament. In the event of first place ties, co-champions will be declared and prize money will be combined and divided equally. To break the tie to determine who goes to the National Tournament, the highest singles game score with handicap will be used, in the event a tie still exists then the second highest singles game score with handicap will be used.

10. You may be requested to verify your age by showing your driver's license, or other proof.

11. Doubles and Singles will be bowled on the same set of lanes. Doubles are bowled first - singles second. Each bowler must have a ball for their own use.

12. Four bowler & Two bowler team members must bowl in the order they are entered on the entry form.

13. In the event of a mechanical failure, it is hereby agreed that the contestants affected shall be moved to the next available pair of lanes.

14. Pacers may be used in the, team event, at the discretion of the manager.

15. All entrants first and last names must be listed, do not list nicknames. Doubles and singles entries must be on the same entry sheet.

16. PENALTIES: Tardy players will start in the frame being bowled with zero being given for each frame missed. Use of ineligible player or reporting incorrect average will nullify all claims for any prize or award.

17. USBC Rule 319-a-3: Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average, whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain or other. If the submitted average is lower than required and results in a lower classification or more handicap, the bowler's score is disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average. In the case of a team of two or more bowlers, the averages will be combined to determine if the correct total is higher or lower than the submitted total. Rules 319-a-2, 319-d and 319-e will be waived.

Average corrections can be made up to the end of the first game of a series. Or, if an extension of time has been granted in writing by tournament management before the end of first game of a series, the correction can be made within 48 hours after the end of the series.

18. Protests of errors in scoring or calculation must be made in writing to the tournament management within 24 hours after bowled or the scores will stand as scored.

19. Participants will be reclassified to the proper class in accordance with their age at time of participation, if different than their entering age.

20. Management reserves the right to rerate or reject any entry prior to bowling.

21. All prize money will be returned 100% in the event in which it was received.

22. All Entry Fees must be paid in full and must accompany the entry form. Make remittances payable to KANSAS STATE SENIOR BOWLING TOURNAMENT. No entry fees will be refunded.
